WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL!

Goodbye summer, HELLO school year! It's fun to have a break from Volume 6, Issue 2 the everyday, but 3 months is usually long enough for children AND their parents! As exciting as going back to school is, it can also be intimidating. Not just for Kindergarten but all grades. Here are a few ways to help keep the new school year going smoothly.

Communication is key! Stay in touch with your child's teacher.

Encourage your children to communicate with their teachers too! 1. **FAMILY CALENDAR:** Get a family calendar. This is where you can post everyone's activities including practices, games, social events, dr. appointments and more. It's a good idea to use a different color for each member of the family. That way you know who is supposed to do what, with just a glance!

2. <u>BE PREPARED</u>: Talk to your child about the things that he/she might experience. (What's going to happen on bus routes, during drop off, during lunch, during pick up.) Take a few minutes each morning to go over Bus numbers, phone numbers and a transportation plan. It's a good idea to put a tag in or on your younger child's back pack with his bus number and a phone number, that way if he forgets it will be close by.

3. **TRANSPORTAITON PLAN:** KNOW YOUR BUS NUMBER. Your child should know his bus number. He should also know to look at the number on the bus to be sure it's his before getting on the bus. Kids need to pay attention so they DO NOT get off at the wrong stop and need to know WHEN to get off at their stop.

4. <u>UPDATE INFOI</u> Make sure your information is always kept up to date with the school AND the daycare. Be sure to notify us when your child will NOT be at the daycare, if they aren't on the bus/van, we can only assume that they should have been and we will call the public school immediately to find them. It makes it easier on us and them if you keep us up to date.

5. <u>PLAN AHEAD</u>: Take some time every night before school. Pack lunches, pick clothes, set alarms, make sure projects are done. It helps to have bins that keep your week organized. M,T,W,TH,F bins are a good tool. That way on Monday soccer uniforms will be at the ready and Tuesday dance clothes are ready. This also helps you get out of the door faster in the mornings. Teach your children to help you stock the bins every Sunday night so the whole family is ready for the week!
